

submit questions, and access the newsletter archive. IRT social media channels (#IRTsWin) are the best way to connect with training activity in your community and across the country. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and LinkedIn offer engaging content that chronicles the partnerships between Servicemembers and local communities to meet IRT mission objectives.

On the personnel side, OSD allocates funding for IRT Program Managers (PMs) to represent training interests of the Services. Six core IRT PMs (see image) serve on behalf of each Active, Reserve, and Guard component in the departments of the Army, Navy, and Air Force. Throughout the year they work closely in a joint capacity to ensure IRT mission planners and participants have access to the tools and resources they need to drive successful civil-military partnerships. Among their numerous duties, perhaps the most tangible are day-to-day facilitation of the application process and coordination between the Services and communities. These IRT PMs are the primary conduit of information during mission planning and execution.
