IRT Delivers Emergency Management Training in Hawaii

From April 23, 2023 to May 6, 2023, the Air National Guard (ANG) led the Kaua'i Emergency Management Agency—Operations Plan Update mission to provide no-cost administrative and technical support to the Kaua'i community. The Utah 151st Air Refueling Wing, California 163rd Civil Engineering Squadron (CES), Iowa 185th CES, and the

Vermont 158th CES ANG units collaborated on this joint mission to provide assistance in updating and publishing the county's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).

Eleven training days were conducted during the mission. Ten service members received 84 hours of training per person, a total of 840 hours of training in real-world emergency management across 36 Training and Readiness Standards. The areas trained include Program Review, Emergency Management Planning, and Resource Management. Airmen drafted documents and identified the relevant stakeholders within the community. They drew on their critical thinking skills, emergency management training, and collaboration skills to execute the mission. The work was carried out in the town of Lihue at the KEMA offices and the Emergency Operations Center (EOC). This work significantly accelerated the timeline for updating and publishing the county's EOP, as well as saving the community a significant amount of time and money.

While the work was conducted in the town of Lihue, the work accomplished will impact the entire Kaua'i community as well as the state of Hawaii. The mission and its success place the Kaua'i community in a more robust position when addressing disaster response and recovery in times of crisis. Mission success ensures that state and federal disaster resources from FEMA, as well as state agencies, will be available and distributed in an efficient and effective manner. The training efforts of this civil-military partnership imparted significant relief to labor and administrative burden on the community. This combination of training with assistance to America's communities is unique to IRT. Learn more about our program at irt.defense.gov.
